Welcome to the 62nd season of the Paskamansett Bird Club. We are offering new outings, some especially for new birders, and our “tried and true” walks. These events are open to the public and free. Birders of all skill levels are invited to participate. Please join us!

Before each walk:

Please pre-register with the walk leader for more details and to confirm your preferred method of contact. In the event of changes or cancellation, the leader will alert you. The leader’s contact information is in the walk description.

Recommendations for what to bring:

Binoculars (if you have them), insect repellent, appropriate clothing for the weather conditions, hat, closed-toed footwear, snacks and water.

Notes:

Most walks are one to two miles, and last one to three hours.

All persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Codes (for most):

(E) “Easy” -Trails are simple and flat.
(M) “Moderate” -Trails may be a challenge at times, requiring caution.
(C) “Challenging” -Trails may have more challenging terrain, and/or often require a longer distance and/or time.

Birding the Bioreserve with Lynn Abbey This walk takes place EVERY Tuesday.

As one of the largest unfragmented forests in eastern Massachusetts, the Bioreserve protects a special ecosystem that provides habitat for countless wildlife species. Nearly 100 birds breed among the Bioreserve’s deep forests, rare Atlantic white cedar swamps, and clear freshwater ponds and streams.
