

Quick Reference Guide 2023 - 2024 Welcome to the 61st season of the Paskamansett Bird Club! We are offering "tried and true" walks and trips, as well as some new ones, which are open to the public and free (unless otherwise noted). Birders of all skill levels are invited to participate. Before each walk:

Please pre-register with the walk leader for more details and to confirm your preferred method of contact. In the event of changes or cancellation, the leader will alert you. The leader's contact information is in the walk description.

Recommendations for what to bring:

Binoculars (if you have them), insect repellent, appropriate clothing for the weather conditions, hat, closed-toed footwear, snacks and water.

Notes:

Most walks are one to two miles, and last one to three hours.

All persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Codes (for most):

E = Easy -Trails are simple and flat.
M = Moderate -Trails may be a challenge at times, requiring caution.
C = Challenging -Trails may have more challenging terrain, and/or often require a longer distance and/or time.

As one of the largest unfragmented forests in eastern Massachusetts, the Bioreserve protects a special ecosystem that provides habitat for countless wildlife species. Nearly 100 birds breed among the Bioreserve's deep forests, rare Atlantic white cedar swamps, and clear freshwater ponds and streams.
